Userhook To Fetch Latest Interest Rate of an Account

Product: Finacle Core Banking | Version: 11.x

The product **userhook urhk_getInterestRateForAccount** can be used to fetch the latest interest rate of an account. This userhook accepts the below inputs, of which **getEITIntRate** is an optional input.

- BANCS.INPARAM.acctNum
- BANCS.INPARAM.asOnDate
- BANCS.INPARAM.balance
- **BANCS.INPARAM.getEITIntRate (optional)**

If the variable **getEITIntRate** is not provided to the userhook, it defaults to 'Y' in the product. When **getEITIntRate** is 'Y', the interest rate is retrieved from the **EIT** table. However, there are many cases where the **EIT** table does not contain the most recent interest rate. For instance, when a preferential rate is added to an account, the **EIT** table's **INTEREST_RATE** might not reflect the correct latest rate unless accrual or booking is performed on the account.

When using the **urhk_getInterestRateForAccount** userhook in scripts, it is best practice to set **getEITIntRate** to 'N' to ensure the latest interest rate is fetched accurately. If the user wants to explicitly retrieve the **EIT** table's **INTEREST_RATE**, they can either call the userhook with only the first three mandatory inputs or pass 'Y' as the value for the **getEITIntRate** variable.

Ticker Functionality
Product: Finacle Online Banking | Version: 11.0.x onwards

Ticker is utilized for sharing information with all users, whether it’s promoting a product, announcing maintenance activities, or delivering security messages. A message can be displayed in the application’s header, ensuring it remains visible across all pages. Ticker can be created through the admin application and will be displayed to retail and corporate users based on the selected user type.

- There are two types of **Ticker** and they are
 - One Time:** The message will be displayed to the user once
 - Recurring:** The message will continuously scroll for the user

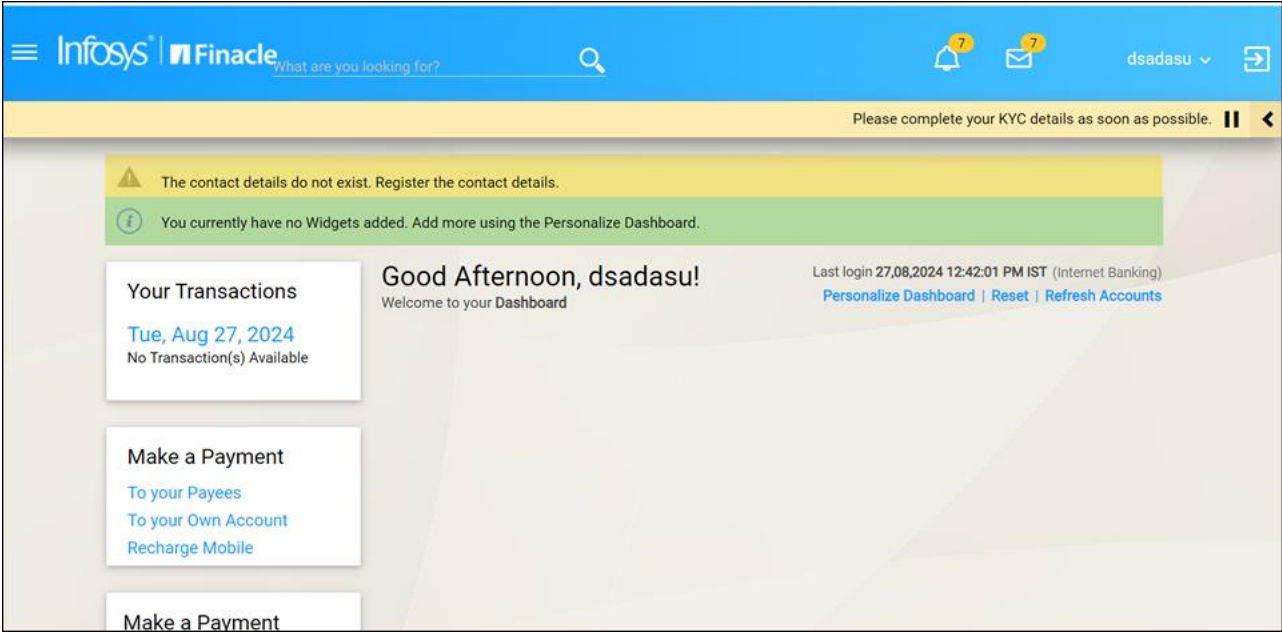
