Card Number Masking in Uniser

Product: Finacle Connect 24 Version: 10.2.x

Finacle provides a card number masking facility at the Uniser level. This feature is enabled in the product based on the **COMT** parameter.

The following are the **COMT** parameters available for masking at the Uniser level.

CARDNO_MASKING_START_INDEX – This parameter decides the index for masking the card number from right to left. A value of **5** means masking from the 5th position from right to left and the last 4 digits will be displayed

CARDNO_MASKING_LEN – This parameter decides the length to mask from the index mentioned above. If the value is **9** it will mask the 9 digits from the **5th** position from right to left

If any of the above parameters is set to **0**, or the index is greater than the actual card number length then no masking will happen. For example, with a 16-digit card number 4641234567891947, for masking it as 464XXXXXXXXX1947, the value of the parameters in the **COMT** table should be set as below:

CARDNO_MASKING_START_INDEX – 5

CARDNO_MASKING_LEN – 9

The card number will be masked in the Uniser logs as below:


Viewing License Details in Finacle Core

Product: Finacle Core Banking Version: 10.2.x

Finacle licenses are deployed during installation. The bank has a provision to inquire about deployed licenses through config editor. In case there is any issue related to the license and the parameters need to be checked, then this can be done from the config editor solution in the Front End.

Sample steps to access the license details in the Front End are given below:

Login to Finacle → Solution "Config Editor" → Configuration → License → License Details.



The configuration and license information are saved in the database under the schema "CEADM". Below are the tables related to License:

LICDETAILSTAB	It contains data in encrypted form. This table must have only one row at any given point in time.
LICAUDITTAB	This contains the timestamp of the old license and the new license uploaded.
